IMPACT OF SEMAGLUTIDE

When used in conjunction with diet and exercise, Semaglutide has been shown to:

- Delay stomach emptying leaving you feeling full and satisfied with smaller meal sizes.
- Lowers blood sugars, in part by reducing the production of sugar in the liver.
- Stimulates insulin secretion by the pancreas.
- Increase self-esteem

Vitamin B6 plays a role in the metabolism of protein, carbohydrates, and fats, and the production of neurotransmitters. It does an excellent job of turning food into energy. This vitamin also helps to treat nausea.

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS >

Though rare: nausea, diarrhea, vomiting, constipation, stomach pain, headache, fatique, dizziness, bloating, gas, and heartburn have been reported.



INTERACTIONS

Do not take with other GLP-1 agonist medicines such as: Adlyxin, Byetta, Bydureon, Ozempic, Rybelsus, Trulicity,

ADMINISTRATION

Victoza, Wegovy.



- Semaglutide+B6 is injected under the skin (subQ) in your stomach, thigh, or upper arm.
- Use Semaglutide+B6 one time each week, on the same day each week at any time of day.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Is Semaglutide a stimulant?

No, while other weight loss medications, like phentermine, have stimulating effects that help curb your appetite, Semaglutide works differently.

Does Semaglutide curb your appetite?

Yes, it is believed that Semaglutide can help curb your appetite. In addition to slowing gastric emptying to make you feel fuller longer.

How much weight can I expect to loss when taking Semaglutide?

More than 50% of trial participants lost 15% of their body weight, and anywhere between a third to 40% of participants lost 20% of their body weight.

Where will I buy my Semaglutide?

Is Semaglutide covered by my insurance?

How long does it take to lose weight on Semaglutide?

You will slowly work your way up to the target dose at which time you will see the most amount of weight loss. In a trial that measured outcomes at 20 weeks, most participants were able to reach the full dose and lost weight as their dose was increased. They saw additional weight loss over the remaining 48 weeks at the full dose. It is important to keep in mind that weight loss can take time, and you'll see the best results when you are using your medication in combination with a healthy diet and exercise. Sometimes the medication may not work for you, or you may not be able to tolerate the full dose due to side effects.
